Course Objectives / Description

Community-acquired pneumonia (CAP) in the elderly is a growing problem due to increasing population of the elderly, high incidence and mortality, emerging problem of antimicrobial resistance and decreasing choice of new antimicrobials. Since Streptococcus pneumoniae is the most common cause of CAP, the Course will especially address new preventive strategies that are underutilized in the prevention of invasive pneumococcal disease including CAP. The course will provide participants with updated background information and a practical approach to all the concerns and disputable issues with leading experts in the field.
