CARICATURE OF CARUSO MAKING A RECORD Drawn by himself












Caruso had a persistant "cold", and complained of severe headaches

Three days after, Caruso became acutely dyspneic and cyanotic.


The distress is relieved by an immediate thoracentesis.

a surprise to Before he "Caruso's death is me," said Dr. Erdmann. "Before he left for Italy, radiographs were made of the parts of his body which had been affected, and the X-rey pictures were inspected by all the physicians and surgeons who had attended the singer.

"It was the unanimous verdict that Caruso could recover completely. Not one of the pictures gave the least indication of future trouble. There was no sign of pus in any of them."








